- \* Make a dish using pumpkin in your recipe.
- \* Ghost and Pumpkin bowling. Paint large disposable cups white and draw a ghost face on the front. Stack them up in rows, decreasing the number of cups as you go up. Step back and roll your pumpkin down the alley. How many ghost pins can you knock over?
- \* Make pumpkin ghosts out of tissue paper. Hang them from your ceiling fan. Turn the fan on low for a ghostly experience.
- \* One of my favorite fall photos is when I arranged a fall photo shoot using jack-o-lantern pumpkins and other fall plants from my yard. My daughter had those missing front teeth at the time, so it made a great scrapbook page.
- \* Make a haunted house in your garage. I remember neighbors doing this when I was growing up. One year we hosted a Halloween party for friends and we turned the garage into a Halloween maze.
- \* Create a fall scavenger hunt in your neighborhood or the local forest preserve.
- \* Make homemade chili and share with your neighbors.
- \* Go to a corn maze or sunflower maze. Who has the best sense of direction in your family?
